Dear Parent/Guardian,

As part of our topic on the Romans, I have arranged for Year 3 to take part in the Dewa Roman Experience in Chester on Thursday 18th October.

During the trip, children will experience what life was like as a Roman Soldier. They will take part in a Roman workshop. The children will be looking at real artefacts focusing on the Roman kitchen, Roman buildings and they will become Archaeologists looking through different materials that were used in Roman times.

The Roman Soldier Patrol includes:

- Following instructions from an experienced legionary whilst marching around the Roman walls of Chester
- Discovering what it takes to become part of the greatest fighting force the world has ever known
- Learning how to train and march as a Roman Soldier
- Teaching children how to defend the walls and prepare for battle
- Taking a look inside a Roman amphitheatre and discovering what events took place many years ago

The Roman Workshop includes:

- Taking a look inside Roman houses and discovering what life was like for a Roman family
- Browsing the different Roman artefacts that have been found by archaeologists
- Looking at the different foods that the Romans ate compared to what the children eat today
- Understanding about Roman health, hygiene and medicine
- Mosaic making and being involved in physical games that the Romans created

Children should arrive to school in full school uniform at the usual time of 8:50am. We will leave school at 9:30am, returning at approximately 3pm. Children will require a packed lunch. If your child usually has a school meal and requires a packed lunch from school, please let the school office know as soon as possible.
