As part of our ongoing commitment to quality provision in English, we will be holding a termly Spelling Bee in each classroom. In the summer term, we will hold a live final where the winners of each term will take part in the ultimate St. Elizabeth's Spelling Bee.

Please find attached the spellings for autumn, spring and summer. These spellings have been chosen to offer the right level of challenge for the children. During the week of the 4<sup>th</sup> March, we will start our Spring Spelling Bee, and the format will be as follows:

#### **HEAT 1**

Takes place as a traditional written spelling test, in classes. The winning children from each class will go forward to heat 2.

#### **HEAT 2**

Will also take place in the classroom. Children will compete in an oral style 'Spelling Bee' which will see us crown a spring spelling champion from each year group.

The oral round will cover all spelling lists (and some unseen ones too) and is designed to steadily increase in difficulty. We hope in this way to ensure success for all, whilst also discovering our ultimate champions!

The winners from the autumn, spring and summer Spelling Bee will compete in the ultimate St. Elizabeth's Spelling Bee Competition at the end of the year. These dates are on the school calendar. In the meantime, get spelling!
