CHRISM MASS. Fr. Nick writes: Every year on the Wednesday of Holy Week our Diocese comes together for this big celebration. The majority of the priests attend and they renew their commitment to the priesthood. The Bishop blesses three large jugs of oil, which are then divided between all the different parishes for use in the celebration of the sacraments throughout the year ahead. The event rotates around the parishes of our large Diocese. This year Wythenshawe is very privileged to host this Chrism Mass at Saint Anthony's. If you have never witnessed this, it is well worth coming and taking part!

WHAT IS HAPPENING AT ST. ANTHONY'S. As previously explained, the Diocese have plans to knock down the old Presbytery and Centre. They will then build a new Presbytery and Centre. Plans are proceeding on time so far, but work will start at the earliest in the autumn. Even then, it will not be completed until spring. Of course, with delays, completion might be later than this.
