## RE: I-Matter Relationship and Sex Education Curriculum Update – Years 4, 5 and 6

You may be aware that our school is part of the Manchester Healthy Schools Award Scheme. To enable us to continue to improve the health and well-being of our pupils, we are reviewing the Relationship and Sex Education curriculum delivered in our school with the view to updating and introducing a curriculum more appropriate for our children, especially in Years 4, 5 and 6. This new programme is called I-Matter. As part of this programme, your child will soon receive a unit of lessons on relationships, sex education and personal safety. These sessions will be delivered by your child's class teacher and our school nurse.
