Dear Parent/Guardian,

The children of Year 5 are learning about World War II as their topic this term. To enhance their learning, we are going to be **visiting Stockport Air Raid Shelters next Thursday 28th November 2019**.

The children will experience the intriguing network of underground tunnels, offering an insight into life in wartime Britain in the 1940s. They will have the opportunity to learn about the experiences of local people during the war from the displays in the tunnels and from the state-of -the-art audio-guides.

To enhance the children's experience, we ask that the children dress up as an evacuee. Here are some pictures to use for ideas. Please be aware that the shelters are very cold, so I would advise long trousers, tights, jumpers and a warm coat.



The suggested contribution towards the cost of the trip is £8. However please be aware that the trip will only be able to take place if enough contributions are received.

We ask that all children bring a packed lunch on that day. However, if your child usually has a hot school dinner and they would like a packed lunch provided by school instead, please let the office know by Monday 25th November. **Packed lunches for those entitled to free school meals** can also be provided by school, again please let us know if your child needs a school packed lunch by Monday 25th November.
