Re: possible reopening of school to more pupils in June

Dear Parents/Carers,

Following my letter, dated the 20th May, I am writing to give you an update in plans for the potential reopening in June.

As stated previously, in a letter from our CEO, the Trust Directors have decided that they will make a decision on the reopening of school on the 8th June and if agreed, set the date that will happen. The decisions on opening follow extensive action planning and risk assessments. The earliest St Elizabeth's will open could be the 15th June; however, at the moment this is not guaranteed.

It was agreed at the last meeting that if we are to open, it will be a phased opening for Year 6 at first, followed by a different start date for Year 1 and then a further start date for Reception. Because of social distancing, the subsequent reduced class sizes, reduced staffing and the number of classrooms available, we are not planning to be open for Nursery children until further notice. We apologise for the difficulty this may cause; however, this decision is made on the grounds of health and safety and capacity.

Thank you for your understanding during these unprecedented times.
