What your donation could fund



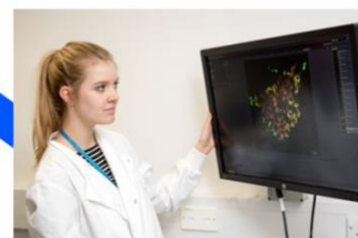
