What is Zoom?

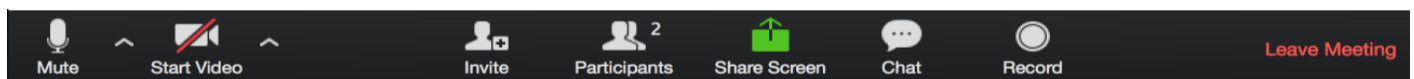
When you join a Zoom meeting hosted by another user, you are considered an attendee. The user who scheduled the meeting or was selected as the alternative host (if the host is unable to join) will have **host controls**, including muting audio, using video, sharing your screen and more. Each meeting has a unique 9, 10, or 11-digit number called a **meeting ID** that will be required to join a Zoom meeting

How do I join a Meeting?

Join a meeting by clicking on a Zoom link provided by the meeting host, follow the prompts to run Zoom, enter the meeting ID if prompted or password, click to join the audio conference. When you're in the meeting, you may click on the Start Video button to start your video.

How do I mute/unmute my audio?

You can mute and unmute your microphone. The host also has the ability to mute you. If you click on the arrow next to the mute button, you will have additional options for audio settings. You can change your microphone, leave the computer audio or access the audio options.



Zoom App

You don't need to download the Zoom app to join the meeting however if you would like to you can join the app for free. It is completely secure and easy to use and can be downloaded via the following link:

1. Once downloaded open the Zoom desktop app.
2. Click **Join a Meeting** and enter the **meeting ID** number, password and your display name.
3. Select if you would like to connect audio and/or video and click **Join**.
