Year 6 Trip to The Liverpool Maritime Museum

Dear Parents and Carers,

Next week Year 6 will begin a new topic, 'The Rescuers' during our topic work we will be learning about the story of two lesser-known heroes of the Titanic - Molly Brown and Harold Bride. To further our learning, we will be visiting The Liverpool Maritime Museum on Wednesday 10th November. During the day the children will visit the Titanic Memorial and visit the museum's exhibition which explores Liverpool's central role in the Titanic Story. We will also take part in a workshop, 'Titanic Voyage of Discovery.'

Children will need to be in school at 8:45am. The coach is expected to arrive back to school at 3:30pm. Children will need to bring a packed lunch in a disposable carrier bag. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, please notify the school office if you would like a packed lunch to be provided from school.

Please ensure your child is wearing their full school uniform, we will provide each child with a school jacket. The children will be travelling on a coach with Year 5 who will be attending The Liverpool World Museum.

The cost of the trip is £11.50. This can be paid via ParentPay. The cost of the trip is voluntary. Please ensure payments are made by Friday 5th November. Should there be insufficient voluntary contributions received, the trip may have to be cancelled.
