Dear Parents/ Carers

Yesterday Pope Francis called for Ash Wednesday to be a day of prayer and fasting for peace in Ukraine. During Mass and throughout the day we dedicated our prayers to Ukraine and her people. Many of us are very shocked by what we have seen on the news and are struggling to understand why this is happening.

Today, we met with Pupil Parliament to discuss what we could do to support Ukraine. We have decided to support a local appeal for items which will be taken to the Polish border to assist refugees. The refugees are mainly women and children who need help with essential items. The majority of people have left the Ukraine with only limited luggage and funds.

We have been asked to collect the following items:

Nappies
Crayons/small Toys
Sanitary Towels
Towels
First Aid Kits
Bandages
Sleeping Bags
Metal Cups
Thermal Clothing
Hair brushes
Shampoo
Toothbrushes / toothpaste
Foil Survival Blankets

The items will be taken to the collection point on Thursday 10th March.
