## Year 6 Trip to The Liverpool Maritime Museum

Dear Parents and Carers,

Next half term Year 6 will begin a new topic, 'The Rescuers' during our topic work we will be learning about the story of two lesser-known heroes of the Titanic - Molly Brown and Harold Bride. To further our learning, we will be visiting The Liverpool Maritime Museum on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> October. During the day the children will visit the Titanic Memorial and visit the museum's exhibition which explores Liverpool's central role in the Titanic Story. We will also take part in a workshop, 'Titanic Voyage of Discovery.'

Children will need to be in school at 8:45am. The coach is expected to arrive back to school at 3:00pm. Children will need to bring a packed lunch in a disposable carrier bag. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, please notify the school office if you would like a packed lunch to be provided from school.

Please ensure your child is wearing their full school uniform, we will provide each child with a school jacket. The children will be travelling on a coach with Year 5 who will be attending The Liverpool World Museum.
