Short Breaks

Manchester City Council provides a range of Short Break services for disabled children and young people with Special Educational Needs, rare disorders and chronic medical conditions age 0 - 17 years inclusive. Call 0161 219 2125 to apply and find out more.



Family Fund

Family Fund grants are available for families on a low income, raising a child or young person aged 17 or under with a long-term disability, disabling condition or life-limiting illness. Grants depend on available funding. To decide if your family is eligible for a grant, Family Fund look at your income and the impact of disability on your child. Visit: www.familyfund.org.uk
